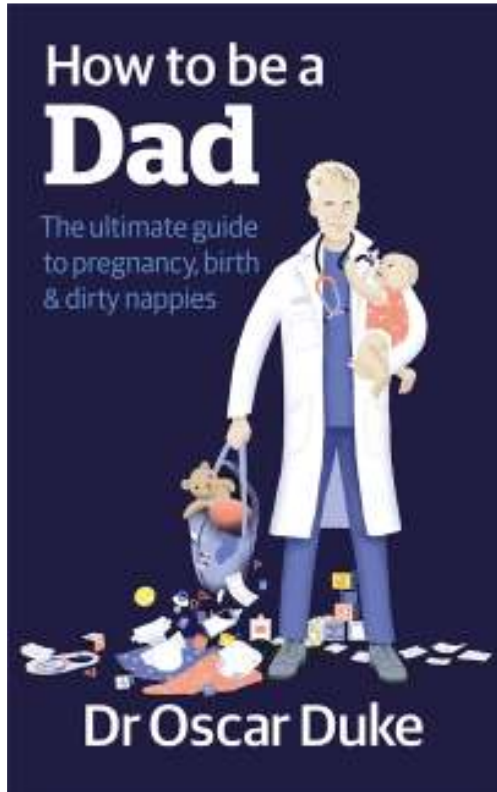


What's On In June

Independent Bookshop Week celebrates independent bookshops in the UK and Ireland. Brook's will be taking part for the first time in this great campaign and we invite you to join us!

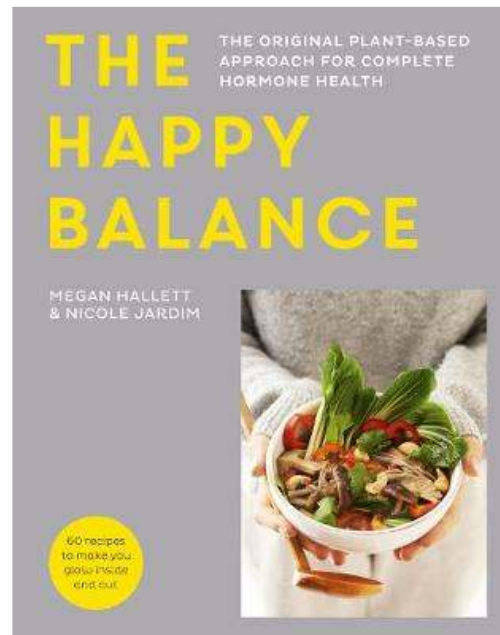

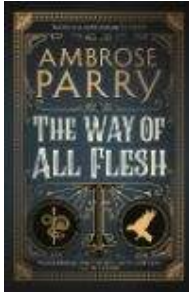
No Longer Alone - Robyn Wilson-Owen

Our book clubs are free to sign up for - just let us know which one you'd like to attend! We also offer 10% off the book for the club you're attending.

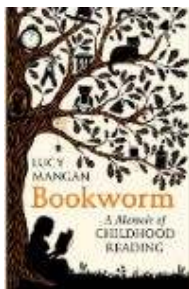
