

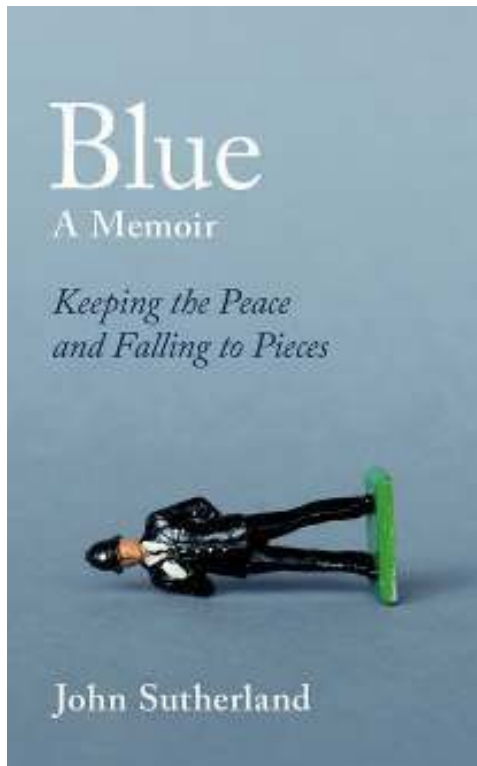

This October half-term we're having a very special visit... from the Gruffalo himself!

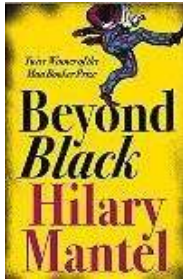
Not only can you meet the Gruffalo (and maybe he'll even sign your books!) but we're offering 10% off all Gruffalo books on the day.

Both the morning and afternoon sessions are free, and will last for 1 hour.



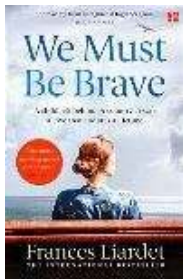
